

Indian Overseas Bank E-Payment of Direct Taxes User Manual – For Customers

- ∞ To remit direct taxes online, the user should:
 - Have a valid TAN or PAN number
 - Should have an account with any of our networked branches and
 - Should register for E-See Banking (Internet Banking) facility with funds transfer facility.
- ∞ The user has to log in to the NSDL site <https://tin.tin.nsdl.com/etax> where the names of the Banks which are offering online payment facility are listed. The user has to select Indian Overseas Bank to proceed.
- ∞ Alternatively, customer can log in to <http://incometaxindia.gov.in> and select “Pay Taxes Online” link which will take the user to the first mentioned site.

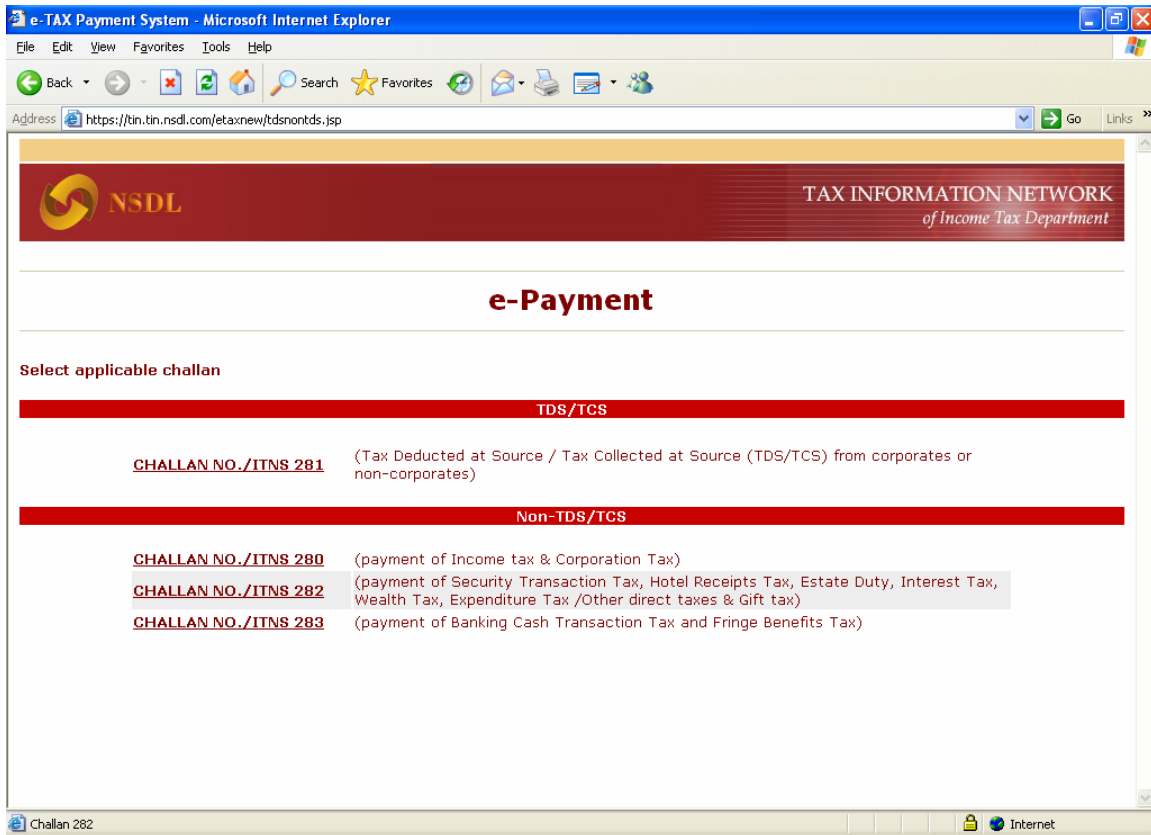
Procedure for e-payment:

2. Enter its PAN / TAN as applicable. There will be an online check on the validity of the PAN /

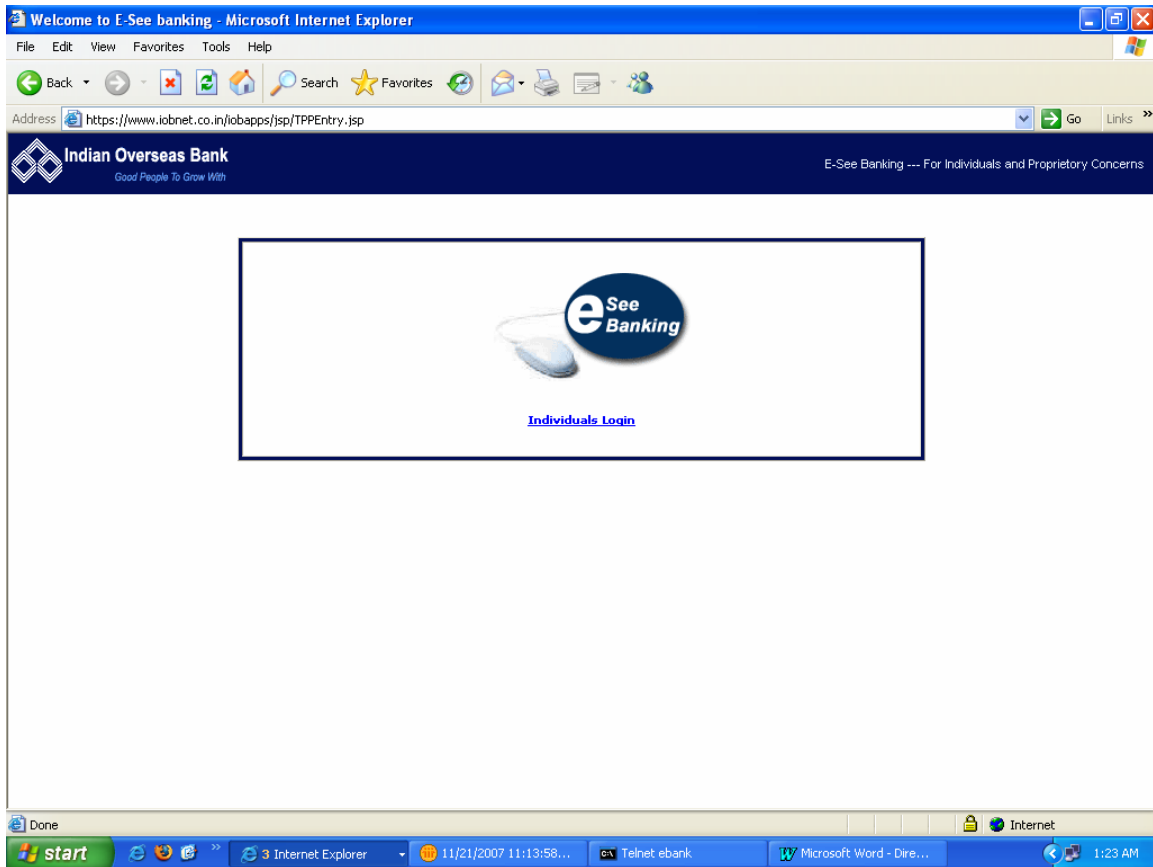

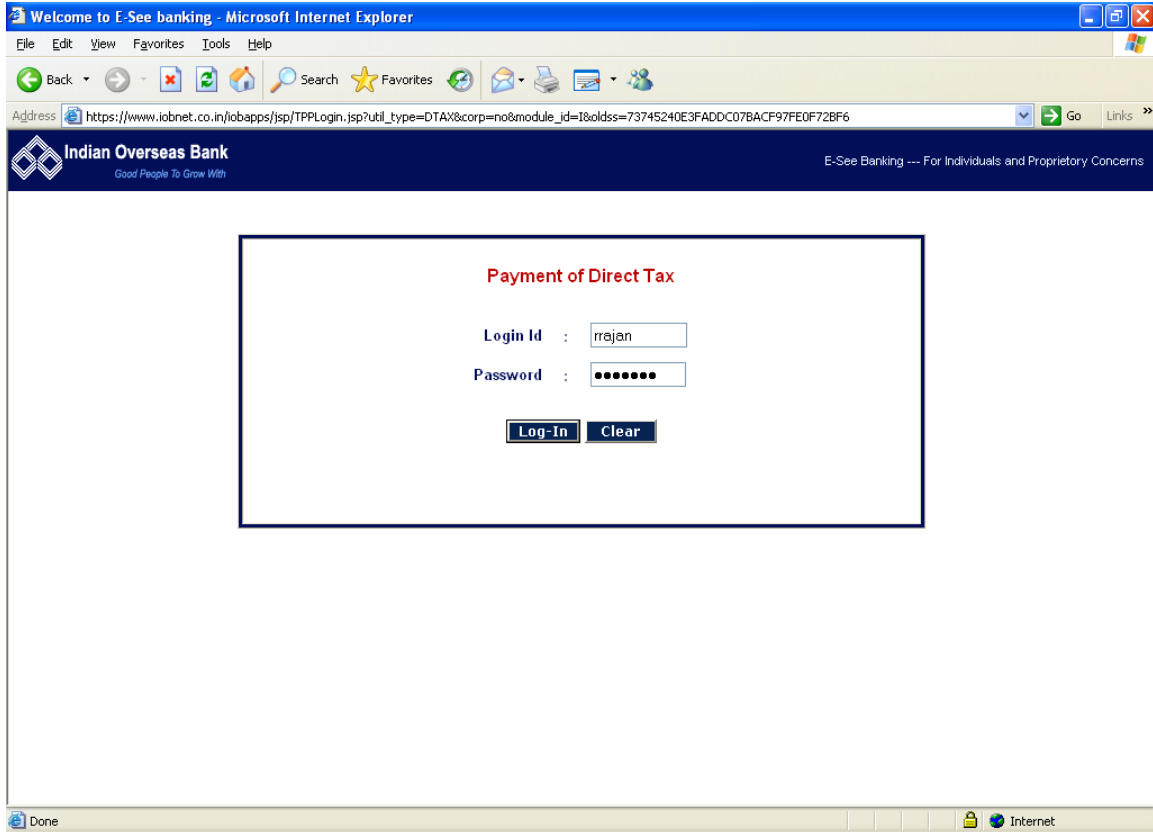


