



## COVID 19-related PHISHING Campaign

Cyber criminals are planning a large-scale phishing campaign targeting individuals and businesses (small, medium, and large enterprises) tricking to register personal information in order to receive an economic stimulus / reimbursement of COVID-19 treatment from Govt of India authorities.



- Check the emails with the subject: **free COVID-19 testing for all residence of Delhi, Mumbai, Hyderabad, Chennai and Ahmedabad**, inciting them to provide personal information.
- The phishing mails may purportedly from Govt of India authorities [spoofing [ncovid19@gov.in](mailto:ncovid19@gov.in) or similar].
- These phishing emails are designed to drive recipients to fake websites where they will be deceived into divulging personal and financial information.

### Do's

- Keep up-to-date patches and fixes on the operating system and application software.
- Scan for and remove suspicious e-mail attachments
- Maintain up-to-date antivirus.
- Change your passwords regularly.

### Don'ts

- Don't open attachments in unsolicited e-mails.
- Never click on a URL contained in an unsolicited e-mail.
- Disable unnecessary services on agency workstations and servers.
- Do not provide your username, password, date of birth, Aadhar NO, or other personal information in response to such emails.
